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

Your child

- as successfully completed the **4th grade of elementary school** in the 2025–2026 academic year and
- is still **11 years old on September 30, 2026**



Your child can enroll in the 5th grade of a **Realschule**, a **Wirtschaftsschule**, or a **Gymnasium**





Your child can enroll in 5th grade at the **municipal orientation program independent of school type** (*schulartunabhängige Orientierungsstufe*) or the municipal Willy Brandt Comprehensive School (see conditions on page)

Enrollment

Please enroll your child at the school where they would like to be admitted. If necessary, your child will usually also take part in a trial lesson at this school. Further information is available from the school itself (see sections 5 and 6).

Enrollment can only be carried out by legal guardians or their authorized representatives. In most cases the signature of one legal guardian is sufficient.

Please bring the following with you to enrollment:

- Original birth certificate
- Original 4th grade transcript (*Übertrittszeugnis*)
- If applicable, original version of guardianship/custody order
- If applicable, certificate of specific learning disability (*Teilleistungsstörung*)



Admission

Your child is accepted for admission to attend 5th grade at the beginning of the school year at a municipal or state-run Gymnasium, Realschule or Wirtschaftsschule.

Secondary schools for university-bound students (*Gymnasien*)

If your child cannot be admitted to the school of your choice, the school administration will endeavor to find a suitable place for your child at another Gymnasium. There is no guarantee of admission to a specific Gymnasium in the state capital of Munich.

Secondary schools offering general education (*Realschulen*)

If your child is not accepted at the selected school, efforts will be made to find a place at another public Realschule in the city. There is no guarantee of admission to a specific Realschule in Munich.

Secondary schools focused on business and economics (*Wirtschaftsschulen*)

Each of the two municipal Wirtschaftsschulen offer 5th grade.

Non-academic secondary schools (*Mittelschulen*)

The dates for pre-enrollment for certain Mittelschulen programs, such as all-day programs, practical classes, or M-classes, can be found on the website of the State Education Authority (schulamt-muenchen.musin.de) and on the websites of the individual schools.

Specialty schools (*Schulen besonderer Art*)

Municipal orientation program independent of school type	+	Municipal Willy Brandt Comprehensive School
„Lottery system“ for admission: All children have the opportunity to enroll in these schools, regardless of their grades in German, mathematics, and social studies on their 4th grade transcript.		

Allocation of places at **municipal orientation independent of school type in Munich-Neuperlach (*städtische schulartunabhängige Orientierungsstufe*):**

Group A: 60 places (20%) for students with a grade point average of 1.00 to 2.33

Group B: 90 places (30%) for students with a grade point average of 2.66

Group C: 90 places (30%) for students with a grade point average between 3.00 and 3.33

Group D: All students who do not belong to groups A, B, or C. This includes students with a grade point average of 3.66 or higher and students from state-approved schools or students from state elementary schools without a 4th grade transcript.

Allocation of places at the Municipal Willy Brandt Comprehensive School:


Group A: 32 places (20%) for students with a grade point average of 1.00 to 2.33
Group B: 48 places (30%) for students with a grade point average of 2.66

Group C: 48 places (30%) for students with a grade point average between 3.00 and 3.33

Group D: 32 places (20%) for students with a grade point average of 3.66 or higher

If more children are registered in the individual groups than there are places available, a lottery will be held. It will take place at the Municipal Willy Brandt Comprehensive School on the day of registration, **Tuesday, May 5, 2026, at 2 p.m.** The lottery at the Munich-Neuperlach Municipal School Type-Independent Orientation Stage will take place on **Thursday, May 7, 2026, at 10 a.m.** If your child does not get a place, you can enroll them at a Gymnasium or Realschule by **Friday, May 8, 2026**, provided that their transcript states that they are suitable for such a school. This also applies if you submit a hardship application after receiving a rejection, which will be decided at a later date.

Free commute to school



You can apply **to have the cost** of public transportation (bus, tram and subway) **covered**. As a rule, this applies to the school that can be reached at the lowest cost. Exceptions can be approved by the Department of Education and Sports.

In its commitment to educational equality, the City of Munich is particularly committed to the implementation of gender-equitable education.


All municipal, state, church, and private girls' schools in the Munich metropolitan area pursue the goal of discovering and promoting the potential of young women and preparing them for active participation in society.

There are many reasons why attending a girls' school can be a particularly beneficial path for your daughter:

- Self-assertion often remains a particular challenge for young women. Girls' schools specifically support and promote a positive self-concept among their students.
- Modern educational concepts of single-sex education allow the school to gear the didactic and methodological setting towards the acquisition of skills among girls.
- Girls find it easier to discover a fascination for scientific subjects among themselves, as they participate more actively in class.



Municipal Willy Brandt Comprehensive School

At the Municipal Willy Brandt Comprehensive School, students can obtain a diploma from a Mittelschule, a Realschule diploma, or eligibility to attend the upper level (10th grade) at a Gymnasium in science and technology.



From grades 5 to 7, students attend a joint core group (class). Upon entering the 8th grade, students decide whether they want to obtain a Mittelschule diploma or a Realschule diploma, or whether they want to pursue a science and technology education track leading to a Gymnasium diploma. In this case, students attend the Municipal Willi Graf Gymnasium starting in the 11th grade.







- Final admission to the evening Gymnasium is contingent upon passing a trial period
- This generally lasts until the interim report card is issued in February
- Applicants who already have a general university entrance qualification, have already twice failed the examination to obtain a technical college entrance qualification, a subject-specific university entrance qualification, or a general higher education entrance qualification, or who have been excluded from attending all colleges, Gymnasien, or technical colleges, cannot be admitted.


